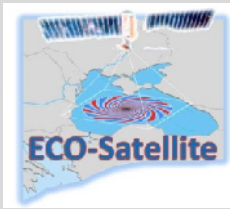

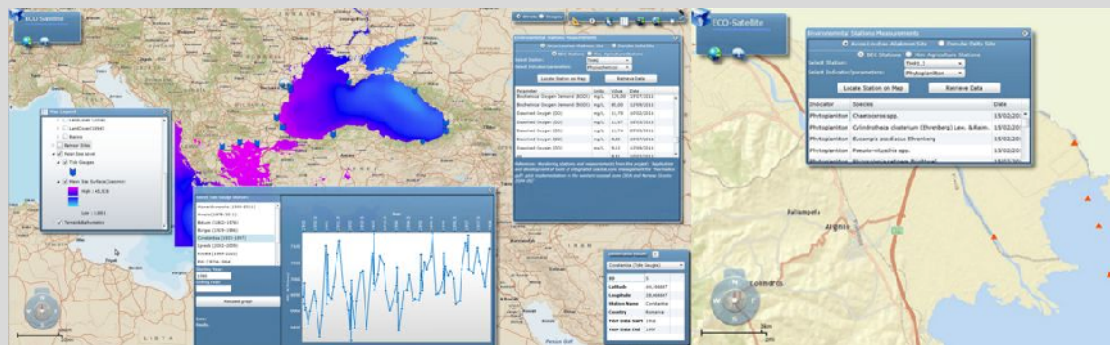
## ECO-SATELLITE

**Development of a common intraregional monitoring system for the environmental protection and preservation of the Black Sea**

The European Project «ECO –SATELLITE» organizes training seminars on the use of the environmental monitoring system that has been developed through the «ECO –SATELLITE» project. The training seminars will take place on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of June 2013 in Varna, Bulgaria.

The training seminars will be attended by representatives from stakeholders from Greece, Romania, Ukraine and Bulgaria. In total 40 trainees are expected to be trained on the use of the monitoring system. With this system, stakeholders will be able to receive important environmental information about major environmental aspects of the Black Sea in order to design their environmental policies.

The training seminars are organized by the Regional Administration of Varna, Bulgaria.

In the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the training seminars, the major results of ECO-SATELLITE will be presented. Then a general presentation of GIS systems and environmental monitoring will follow. After that, the monitoring system that has been developed by ECO-SATELLITE will be presented.

In the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the seminars, trainees will have the opportunity to operate and interact with the ECO-SATELLITE monitoring system with the aid of the trainers.
